



**L Street Running Club
2012 Student Grant**

Objective

The objective of the L Street Running Club (LSRC) Student Grant is to provide financial assistance to two students who fulfill the application requirements. Qualified students may apply for the cash award of \$1,000 which can be spent on the purchase of textbooks or computer equipment. Recipients will be notified by April 5, 2012 and acknowledged at LSRC's Boston Marathon meeting on April 12, 2012.

A \$1,000 check will be sent to recipients in December 2012 upon the successful completion of first semester courses and the intention of continuing to the second semester at the same college or university.

Application requirements

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of the City of Boston.
- Be in the process of acceptance to a two-or four-year college or university for the academic year 2012-2013.
- Be a member of his/her high school track or cross country team for at least two academic years.

Note:

- The applicant's academic record, commitment to community service and financial need will all be considered in the selection process.
- Eligible daughters, sons, nieces and nephews of LSRC members are encouraged to apply.

Application process

- The application must be signed by the student's guidance counselor or coach and mailed to the LSRC (see address below) with the following information:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Home phone number
 - Name of high school and year of graduation
 - Name of college or university applicant will attend
 - An essay written by the applicant stating the reasons why he/she should be selected
