Boston Marathon Invitational Marathon Number Policy

Based on the number of marathon numbers provided by the BAA to the LSRC the following order of distribution is to be adhered to:

1) Board President

2) Board Officers, Directors, Alternates & Appointees (Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Apparel, Events, Media, Membership, Newsletter, Sunshine, (2) Alternates, Race Director and Web Master) all will be selected **by 1 combined lottery**.

- In order for Board Officers, Directors, Alternates & Appointees to qualify for a marathon number they must meet the following criteria
 - Attend seven out of eleven board meeting. Attendance to be kept by President and Secretary
 - Attend 2 out of 5:
 - Attend the Semi-Annual meeting in April and Annual meeting in December.
 - Attend the Jim Kane Packet Stuffing and Jim Kane Race held in July.
 - Christmas Basket
- If the board member does not meet the qualifying standards they will be allowed into the other distribution categories if they meet those areas qualifications.
- Must complete both a fall and spring water stop during marathon training.
- The water stop coordinator is eligible if they sign up for 1 full year of service (both spring and fall marathons)

If numbers are still available:

3) Members who Volunteered at 2 BAA Events + 2 The Run to Remember Events along with the Jim Kane Vendor Coordinator(s): (BAA events include: bag stuffing, vault loading, BAA Marathon expo, BAA ½ Marathon 10k, 5k and the Run to Remember water stop and packet stuffing and/or bib/t-shirt distribution) will be selected. **By lottery.**

If numbers are still available:

4) Volunteered at 2 BAA events and/or 1 BAA event and the Run to Remember Waterstop: (BAA events include: bag stuffing, vault loading, BAA Marathon expo, BAA ½ Marathon 10k, 5k and the Run to Remember water stop and packet stuffing and/or bib/t-shirt distribution) will be selected. **By lottery.**

If numbers are still available:

5) Board designees: A *lottery* will be set up to include the names selected by each board member. Each board member will submit the name of one club member who they believed acted on behalf of the club at an exemplary level (it cannot include those who are already in the lottery for volunteering at the events listed above.) Note: If a club member is nominated more than once by the board they will have the same number of chances as nominations.

NOTES:

- In order to be considered for a marathon number board officers (including the President), board directors including alternates and board appointees must have served at least one complete term.
- The names of LSRC members who volunteer at BAA events will be provide by BAA personal and/or members can submit their volunteer confirmation to the Club's President who will then provide it to the Club's secretary to keep an accurate update list of all volunteer.
- The name of LSRC members who volunteer at the Run to Remember and BAA events will be kept on a list by the President of LSRC who is the clubs contact for the Run to Remember and the BAA.
- The President will notify the Secretary of the club in order to keep an accurate updated list of all volunteer.
- For volunteer members and board designees to be considered for a number, they must be "members in good standing".
- Any number issued is the property of the club. No one receiving a number can transfer it. The number must be returned to the club and follow the order of distribution, to the next eligible person.
- Anyone receiving a number must sign the club's *Boston Bib Acceptance Form* stating that they understand the policy and will follow it before they are given a number.
- All runners must wear L Street apparel and gear while running the marathon if they choose to accept a number from LSRC.

Failure to Adhere to this Policy: Any recipient of an LSRC bib who attempts to alter the Policy themselves in any way, including but not limited to transferring the designated bib, modifying or attempting to change the status of your volunteer work through lying or coercion will be automatically ineligible to a future bib number, even if the recipient meets the criteria set forth in our Policy. The Board of Directors has the authority to remove a member's label of a "member(s) in good standing" and the Board of Directors can vote to remove the recipient from the LSRC membership permanently along with the person who received the stolen bib.

Changes to this Policy: If at any time the LSRC Board of Directors votes to change, modify or update this policy, the membership must be notified in writing through the club's newsletter within 30 days and the policy should be attached. This policy should always be available to the membership on the website listed under the by-laws-and-policies tab.
